Bass

C C C G

Blue Task

Play the tune in your **right** hand - remember the different note values (coloured in = 1 beat / empty = 2 beats).

Keep your playing steady and fluent.

Purple Task

Play the tune with your **right** hand and play the bass note with your **left** hand. This note is held throughout the bar.

You need to play these at the same time.

Chords

C+E+G C+E+G C+E+G G+B+D

Pink Task

Instead of playing just the bass note, now play the full chord in your **left** hand, whilst playing the tune in your **right** hand. A chord is three notes played at the same time.

The chords happen at the same time as the tune.

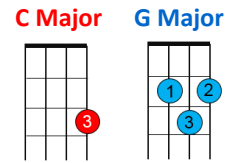

Ode to Joy - Ukulele Melody

Now that you've mastered the melody on Keyboard, have a go on Ukulele. Make sure you read the TAB carefully, and press firmly onto the frets. When you can do it, get your partner to add the chords (as shown by the colour blocks).

Measure 1: 0-0-1-3 | 3-1-0-2 | 0-0-2-0 | 0-2-2-0 | 0-0-1-3 | 3-1-0-2 | 0-0-2-0 | 2-0-0-0

Chord blocks: Red, Red, Red, Blue, Red, Red, Red, Blue, Red

By this point, you've got all the ingredients to put this piece together as a group. Your task is to layer the parts together: Bass, Chords, Melody. You can use a combination of Ukulele and Keyboard for this task. Make sure you keep a steady beat and listen to each other carefully.
