









Have a go at playing this tune on the keyboard with your **right** hand

Your thumb (finger 1) needs to be on a C. Use the picture above for the other finger placements



The coloured in notes are called **crotchets**. They are worth one beat. The open notes are called **minims** and they are worth two beats. Don't forget to count as you play.

Don't forget to support your keyboard partner with successes and next steps throughout the lesson.
