Identifying music from different periods



What are the "fingerprints" of each period of music history

Renaissance



Simple polyphonic style often using imitation



Instruments of the period (lute, viols, recorders, clavichord etc.)



Much choral writing esp. for the church, but also Madrigals (songs)

Baroque:



Many flowing lines of music (polyphonic) weaving together



Instruments of the period



Straightforward harmony with bass continuo ('cello & harpsichord)

Modern



Harmonies become more discordant (dissonant)



Beat/rhythms more irregular



Unconventional ways of playing instruments

Classical:



Stricter structures, shorter phrases and cadence points.



Melody & Accompaniment (homophonic textures)

and

Clear, simple harmonies

Romantic:



Longer melodic lines, and freer structures, emphasis on emotive appeal (dynamic contrasts etc.)



Richer and more chromatic harmonies



Development of brass & percussion sections, and bigger orchestras
