Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart was born in 1756 in Austria.

He was one of the main composers to establish the 'classical' style of writing.

As a very young child, he started playing the Piano and Violin. He wrote his first piece of music at the age of 5, and by the age of 17 he was working as a professional composer.

He composed more than 600 works, many of which are acknowledged as pinnacles of symphonic, concertante, chamber, operatic, and choral music.

Mozart died at the age of 36.

After you've mastered the simplified version, have a go at the original.

The right hand melody is exactly the same.

Make sure you learn the left hand line separately before putting the two together.

Play it slowly to start with and then pick up the speed.
