## Blue Task:

Play through the first four bars of the Surprise Symphony. Accuracy is more important than speed. Make sure there is a clear difference between the one beat notes and the two beat notes.

## Purple Task:

Play the first section of the Surprise Symphony. Watch out for the G<sup>b</sup> (G flat) which is the black key between F and G.
