













 <p>Rhythm</p>	<p>This type of music has 3 beats in a bar</p>	 <p>Waltz</p>	<p>More than one rhythm played at once</p>	 <p>Polyrhythm</p>	<p>The constant, unchanging 'beat'</p>	<p>The symbol that means don't play on a beat</p>
 <p>Pulse</p>	<p>This type of music has 4 beats in a bar</p>	 <p>March</p>	<p>A note that lasts for two beats</p>	 <p>Minim</p>	<p>The person who keeps an orchestra in time</p>	<p>Rest</p>
